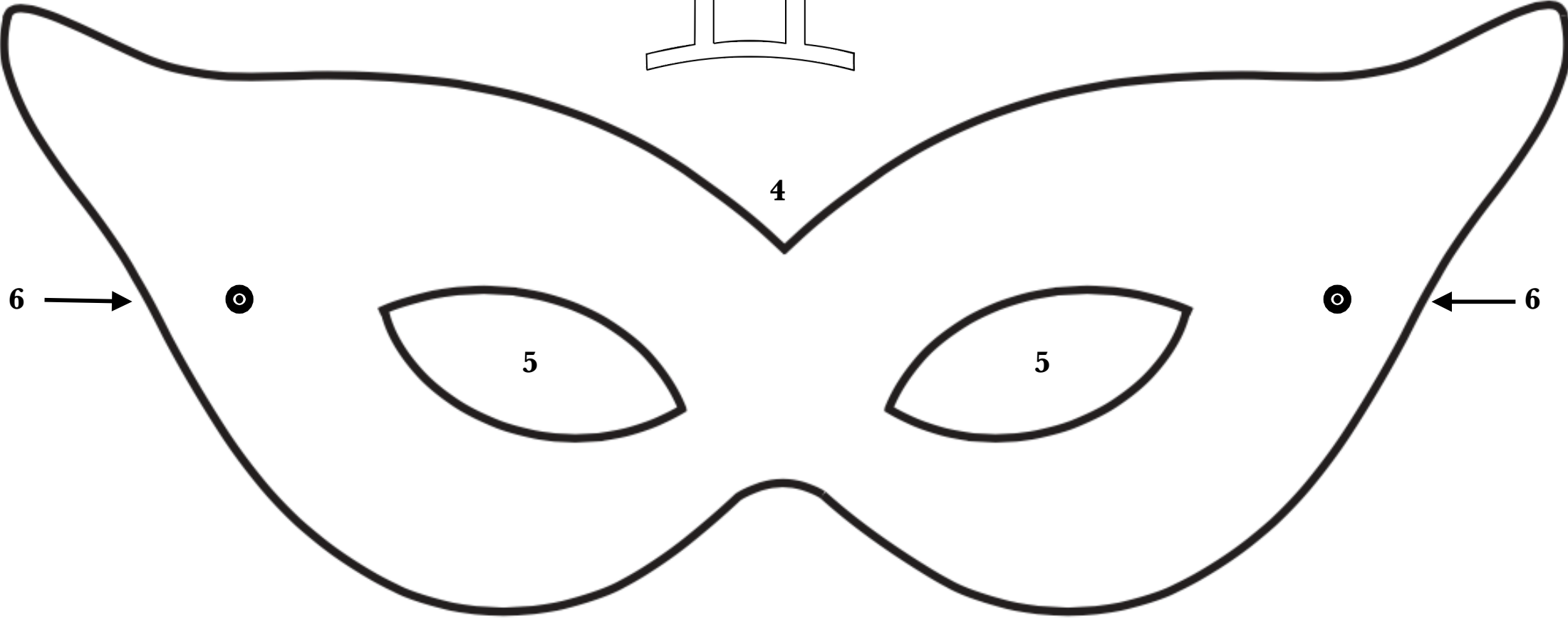
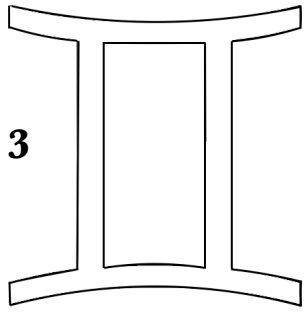


GEMINI



Key to Templates:

- 1) Eyes**
- 2) Eyelashes**
- 3) Aquarius zodiac symbol**
- 4) Mask**
- 5) Eyeholes**
- 6) Holes for elastic**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAKING YOUR COSTUME:

- 1) Print out the first page of this pdf on standard A4 paper (landscape format) and cut out the shapes that are numbered in the template key.
- 2) Set aside the eyes and eyelashes for a moment, and use the paper shapes for the mask and the gemini symbol as templates to cut out the same shapes from a piece of coloured card. The colour suggested here is jade green, to mimic the colours of peacock feathers – but you can use any colour you like.
- 3) Stick the gemini symbol to the centre of the mask, between the eyeholes (see Fig. 1, below, for placement).
- 4) Return to the paper eyes and eyelashes and use felt tip pens to colour in the eyelashes, irises and pupils in your choice of colours. The colour suggested here for the eyelashes and irises is deep blue, to mimic the colour of the eyes on peacock feathers – but you can use any colour you like.

- 5) Stick the coloured-in eyes and eyelashes to the mask (see Fig. 1, below, for placement).
- 6) Use a hole-punch or knife to make the holes for elastic (6) on each side of the mask, and thread with elastic.
- 7) Finish off your costume by wrapping up warm in comfy, waterproof clothes — then make yourself an over-costume, by draping either a scarf, shawl, or large piece of fabric over your shoulders, in a colour that matches your mask (preferably a bright, or metallic colour, to make a more theatrical impact).
- 8) You can make your costume even more theatrical by sticking/sewing coloured fabric ribbons to your over-costume – or add feathers (peacock feathers would work particularly well for this particular costume), tinsel, sequins... or whatever you want, to customise your zodiac sign!
